Helpful Information for future chairs

It worked really well to ask people to BYOB and also bring a salty or sweet snack to share. It is always easier to cut down on costs that way. Also, having it at my house was a little difficult because had there been more people, we would have not had enough room. My place is small, but not unbearable. The rules we used for the game are as follows: Everyone brings one gift, wrapped, to the party. This insures that EVERYONE gets one gift and that no one is slighted. You put numbers into a hat and draw numbers. There should be enough numbers so that everyone gets one. The person who draws number 1 picks a gift from the pile and opens it. The person who drew number 2 goes next. This person can either pick a gift from the pile or the gift from the number one person. If they chose from person number 1, person number one must draw from the pile of gifts. Anytime a gift is "stolen" the person who is left "gift less" will need to pick from the pile. If you do not pick from the pile, but continue to steal gifts from others, the game will NEVER end. I'm sure there are variations on how to play, but these are the rules we used.
